

Who's New In Madison Euchre Extravaganza

The event is comprised of a total of 8 Rounds with each round consisting of dealing 8 hands.

Players will *play as a team and keep a team score* on the sheet provided.

Please be sure to put both first and last name on your score sheet.

<u>At the end of the event</u>, each team should total their score and have it verified by the other team at the table and bring the score sheet to the "Score Master".

The "Score Master" will review all score sheets to determine the top three scores.

Cash prizes will be awarded to the three teams with the highest scores.

Rounds:

Players can sit at any table to start.

One player deals the cards face up to decide who starts the game as dealer. First Jack Deals.

After shuffling the cards, the dealer offers the player to his/her right an opportunity to cut the deck.

When the cards have been dealt and trump decided, the player to the left of the dealer leads.

After the hand is played, the deal passes clockwise around the table.

A round consists of 8 hands (deals) – meaning each player deals twice.

What to do if nobody declares trump (passes) after the turned-up card is turned down:

• The dealer must name trumps (except for the suit turned down) – "Stick the Dealer"

What to do at the end of each round:

- The winning team "Wanders" (goes) to the next higher sequenced number table.
- The losing team "Lingers" (stays) at their table.
- In the event of a tie, one player from each team draws a card. High card is declared the winner.

SCORING:

- Partnership making trump wins 3 or 4 tricks: 1 point
- Partnership making trump wins 5 tricks: 2 points
- Loan hand making trump wins 3 or 4 tricks: 1 point
- Loan hand making trump wins 5 tricks: 4 points
- Partnership or loan hand making trump is Euchred and opponents earn: 2 points (Being "Euchred" is when those making trump do not win at least 3 tricks)

What constitutes a renege: Player MUST play a card of the same suite led if they have one

- o When a player has a card of the led suit but plays a card from a different suit
- o The violation may be caught after a trick is completed, making it a hidden infraction until then

What to do if someone reneges:

- The hand ends immediately the team it occurred against is awarded 2 points
- If it occurs on a loaner hand, the team it occurred against is awarded 4 points

What to do in case of tie "winning" scores at the end of the event:

- The team with the most games won is declared the winner.
- If there's still a tie one player form each draws a card. High card is declared the winner.
- In case the players draw the same ranking card (i.e. two kings), the players draw again. (Note: an Ace is considered the highest card.)
